

# [Video] Da Vinci's Monster Jam Helps Cavs in Must-Win Game

**CLEVELAND, OH** - The Cavs suited up their secret weapon on Saturday: the Da Vinci robot. In his only appearance, Da Vinci James' performance was clutch, so much so that he's already being mentioned in discussions for Finals MVP.
