

Meet the New Hospital Swiss Army Commode

FORT LAUDERDALE, FL - The makers of the Swiss Army Knife, Victorinox, appears to have hit a home run with patients and providers this week with the introduction of their new product, the Swiss Army Commode. This is Victorinox's first venture into medical equipment territory.

The new Swiss Army Commode is encased in a sturdy metal and plastic casing. What [physical and occupational therapists](#) say makes this commode so special are the numerous tools and instruments available at your disposal: seat, toilet,

walker, reamer, wood saw, tweezers, toothpick, key ring, large blade, small blade, Phillips screwdriver, can opener, wire stripper, nail file, umbrella, stethoscope, [incentive spirometer](#), PlayStation 4, and USB cable.

Everyone seems to love the 26-in-1 commode.

“The USB cable is a godsend,” commented cardiac floor nurse Mickey Frails. “I can plug the cable into my computer and BAM!!! The commode uploads all of the patient’s I’s and O’s. Is that not amazing? It’s amazing!”

“I forgot my stethoscope when I went to go see a patient,” admitted orthopedic surgeon Brock Hammersley. “But I just had him sit on the Swiss Army Commode, popped out the stethoscope, listened to his [bones](#), and that’s all she wrote!”
