

Surgeons are Furious! The Bouffant vs. The Skull Cap

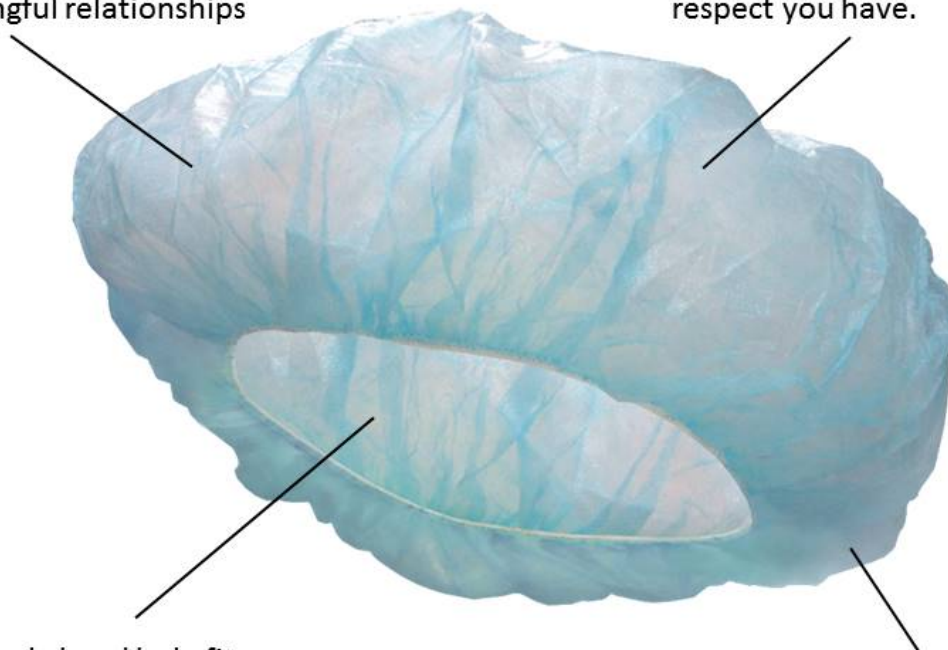
