CONTACT PRECAUTIONS

VISITORS: Report to nurse first. Unless nurse is eating, sleeping, or peeing. Then don't bother.



Gloves

Wear gloves like rubber gloves, baseball gloves, falconry gloves, winter gloves, boxing gloves, fencing gloves, oven mitts, mittens, hockey gloves, even scuba diving gloves would do the trick.



Hand Hygiene

Spitting on hands works just fine.



Gowns

Don gown upon entry and make it striking: a ballroom or wedding gown is quite effective and will ensure you are the life of the isolation room.



Patient Transport

Limit transport of patients to whatever you can squeeze in between charting.

Ensure infected areas of patient's body is buried under 30 layers of gauze or blankets.

Ask someone else to transport patient so you don't have to worry about this gowning business.



Patient-Care Equipment

Tell patient to bring own bed, pillows, TV, phone to make cleaning of equipment easier
