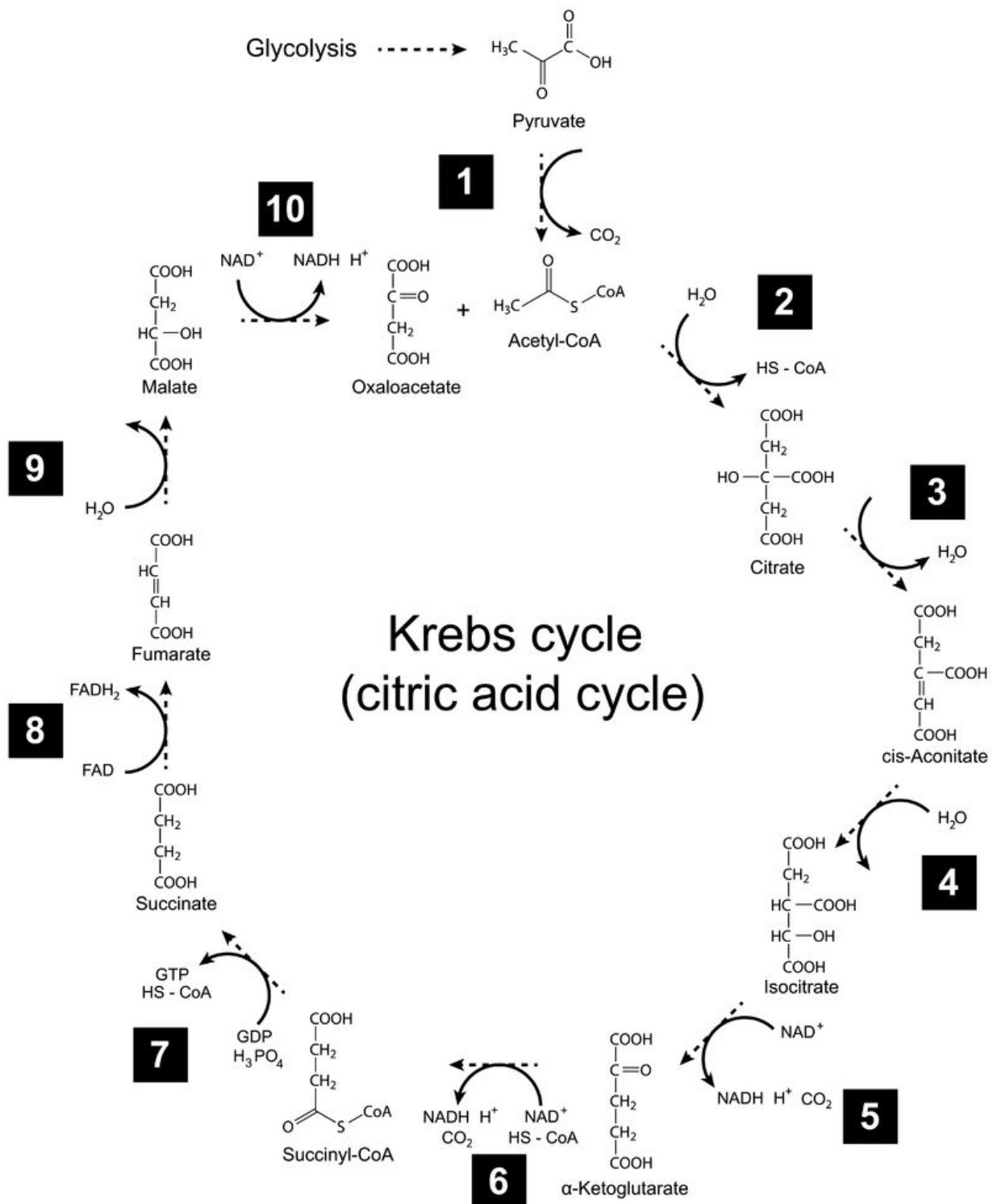


Med Student Wastes Dying Patient's Last Moments on Earth Talking About Damn Krebs Cycle
